Job Description

Role and Responsibilities

This position will be responsible for providing crisis intervention and advocacy services to survivors of domestic violence, sexual assault, human trafficking, and stalking on the University of California, Merced (UC Merced) Campus. The position will also work with VCC and UC Merced staff on outreach activities, training education, presentations, and assist in community organizing around the issue of sexual assault, domestic violence, human trafficking, and stalking in our community. The position will be responsible for learning the University of California state-wide policies and procedures and accommodations related to issues of gender-based violence. The position will be responsible for filling indirect services to victims of domestic violence, human trafficking, and/or sexual assault, which includes crisis intervention and emergency response throughout Merced County when needed, with some after-hours on-call duties. Bilingual/bicultural preferred. Must have a clean driving record and have had a driver's license for at least 5 years. Must show vaccination record upon hire.

Crisis Intervention and Advocacy:

- Provide crisis intervention on the hotline or in-person to victims of domestic violence, sexual assault, human trafficking, and stalking.
- Provide accompaniment, advocacy, and case management services as needed.
- Provides education and interaction with staff and faculty on issues related to survivors and their healing.
- Collaborate with UC Merced campus partners and University of California counterparts in doing advocacy.
- Provide peer counseling and legal services to victims as needed.
- Provide assessments for other VCC services, including shelter and other legal services and referrals as appropriate.
- Responsible for referring individuals to appropriate community resources for additional assistance and counseling.
- Provide consultation and expertise to community partners regarding domestic violence, sexual assault, human trafficking, and stalking.
- Responsible for completing documentation of services and reports in a timely fashion.
- Provide culturally appropriate services and referrals. Coordinates with interpretation services.
- Other duties as assigned.

Community Outreach/Education:

- Provide interactive presentations and training on domestic violence, sexual, human trafficking, and stalking and procedures, protocols, and agency services. These presentations may be after hours or on weekends.
- Research and develop an appropriate curriculum for presentations and training that promotes audience participation and focuses on a proper response, prevention, and ending violence of any kind.
- Assist with research and development of support group curriculum and identifying resources for individuals seeking Valley
 Crisis Center services.
- May serve as a liaison with community groups, offering presentations about Valley Crisis Center.
- Work to secure collaborative relationships with other community partners, both on campus and among the community, to organize events promoting domestic violence and sexual assault awareness and prevention.
- Represents the agency in the community professionally and competently.

Administrative Duties:

- Monitoring program activities to ensure compliance with the program's funding sources.
- Work with VCC's Program Director to track numbers, statistical information, types of presentations given each quarter, and program outcomes.
- Provide support to VCC with outreach, administrative, and development projects as needed.

Qualifications and Education Requirements

- Knowledge Sexual Assault, Domestic Violence, Human Trafficking, and Stalking
- Prevention Education Principles and Strategies
- Peer Counseling and Crisis Intervention techniques preferred
- Computers and Software Programs (Word; Excel; Internet)

- Communicate effectively orally and electronically in writing with individuals and groups from various age groups and backgrounds.
- Demonstrate competency with computer programs.
- Must possess strong public speaking skills.
- Organize and prioritize tasks according to deadlines and client needs.
- Work effectively with limited supervision, high stress, and rapidly changing situations and circumstances.
- Demonstrate sensitivity to the cultural and ethnic diversity of the service population.
